*Ysgol Cynwyd Sant is a Welsh Medium Primary.*

- ⇒ Cyfnod Sylfaen – Cyfrwng Cymraeg yn unig  
*Foundation Phase - Welsh Language only*
- ⇒ Cyfnod Allweddol 2 – Prif gyfrwng Gymraeg ond Saesneg mewn rhai gwersi (ym mlwyddyn 3 bydd gwersi ffurfiol Saesneg yn cychwyn)

*Key Stage 2 - Welsh is the main medium used but English is used in some lessons (in year 3, formal English lessons will begin)*

- ⇒ Cymraeg yw prif gyfrwng cyfathrebu'r ysgol  
*Welsh is the main medium of communication at the school*
- ⇒ Nid oes hawl gan y rhieni dewis cyfrwng cyfathrebu'r ysgol  
*Parents are not able to choose the language in which instruction is given.*

- ⇒ Ysgol Gymraeg ei hiaith ydym ac mae'r disgyblion yn trosglwyddo i **Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Llangynwyd**

## Crefydd, Gwerthoedd a Moeseg Religion, Values and Ethics

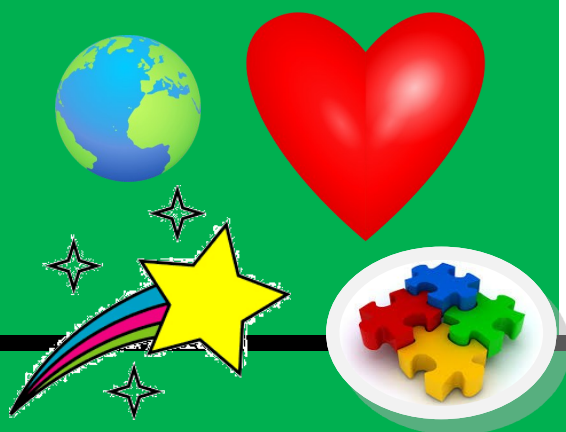

## Cwricwlwm Newydd

Mae Llywodraeth Cymru yn datgan:

*"Bydd y cwricwlwm newydd yn pwysleisio ar roi i bobl ifanc y sgiliau sydd eu hangen arnynt ar gyfer bywyd. Bydd yn datblygu eu gallu i ddysgu sgiliau newydd a defnyddio'u gwybodaeth bynciol yn fwy effeithiol ac mewn ffordd fwy creadigol. Wrth i'r byd newid o'u cwmpas, byddan yn gallu addasu, a hynny mewn ffordd gadarnhaol.*

*Hefyd, cânt ddealltwriaeth ddofn o sut i lwyddo mewn byd sy'n fwyfwy digidol. Mae fframwaith cymhwysedd digidol newydd bellach yn cyflwyno sgiliau digidol ar draws y cwricwlwm, gan baratoi pobl ifanc ar gyfer y cyfleoedd a'r risgiau sydd ynghlwm wrth y byd ar-lein.*

*Hefyd, caiff athrawon fwy o ryddid i ddysgu yn y ffyrdd a fydd, yn eu barn hwy, yn sicrhau'r deilliannau gorau i'w dysgwyr.*

*Prif ffocws y trefniadau asesu fydd sicrhau bod dysgwyr yn deall sut maen nhw'n perfformio a beth mae angen iddyn nhw ei wneud nesaf. Bydd pwyslais o'r newydd ar asesu ar gyfer dysgu fel rhan hanfodol a chraidd o ddysgu ac addysgu."*

# New Curriculum

The Welsh Government states:

*“The new curriculum will have more emphasis on equipping young people for life. It will build their ability to learn new skills and apply their subject knowledge more positively and creatively. As the world changes, they will be more able to adapt positively.*

*They will also get a deep understanding of how to thrive in an increasingly digital world. A new digital competence framework is now introducing digital skills across the curriculum, preparing them for the opportunities and risks that an online world presents.*

*Meanwhile teachers will have more freedom to teach in ways they feel will have the best outcomes for their learners.*

*The central focus of assessment arrangements will be to ensure learners understand how they are performing and what they need to do next. There will be a renewed emphasis on assessment for learning as an essential and integral feature of learning and teaching.”*

The new curriculum will have 6 Areas of Learning and Experience:

1. Expressive Arts
2. Health and Well-being
3. Humanities (including RE which is compulsory to age 16)
4. Languages, Literacy and Communication
5. Mathematics and Numeracy
6. Science and Technology

Language, Numeracy and Digital Competence skills will be taught across all areas of learning and experience.

The **purpose** of the new curriculum is to support the children to be:

1. Ambitious, capable learners.
2. Enterprising, creative contributors.
3. Ethical, informed citizens.
4. Healthy, confident individuals.

## Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol

### *Additional Learning Needs*

Mae cymorth ychwanegol ar gael ar gyfer plant sydd ag anawsterau dysgu ychwanegol. Mae'r cymorth hwn yn dibynnu ar ofynion unigol y plentyn. Mae'r plentyn wedi integreiddio'n llwyr yn y brif ffrwd ond fe ryddhawyd ar adegau ar gyfer cefnogaeth mewn grŵp bach. Mae'r broses yn cael ei monitro yn agos o dan oruchwyliaeth y Cydlynnydd Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol. (CADY).

Y Cydlynnydd ADY, athrawes ddosbarth a'r athrawes gymorth sy'n gyfrifol am lunio Targedau Unigol i bob plentyn sy'n derbyn cefnogaeth ar gyfer anhawster dysgu ychwanegol. Dyfeisir CDU i gefnogi disgyblion ADY i gydymffurfio â Bil ADY newydd.

*There is additional support for a child who has additional learning needs. The support available depends on the individual needs for the child. Each child receiving additional support is fully included in main stream but will be withdrawn in a small groups for short periods of time. The Additional Learning Needs Co-Ordinator (ALNCo) monitors the whole process.*

*The ALNCo, the class teacher and the support teacher are responsible for writing Individual Targets for pupils who require additional support who are experiencing difficulties. IDPs are devised to support ALN Pupils in compliance with new ALN Bill.*

## Cydraddoldeb / Equality

Yn Ysgol Cynwyd Sant rydym yn ymrwymedig i sicrhau addysg gyfartal a chyfle cyfartal i'r holl ddisgyblion, staff, rhieni a gofawyr sy'n cael gwasanaethau gan yr ysgol, ni waeth beth fo'u sefyllfa o ran anabledd, hil, rhyw, oedran, cyfeiriadedd rhywiol, crefydd neu gred, statws ailbennu rhywedd, beichiogrwydd a mamolaeth, priodas a phartneriaeth sifil. Rydym yn amcanu at ddatblygu diwylliant o gynhwysiant ac amrywiaeth lle mae pawb sy'n gysylltiedig â'r ysgol yn falch o'u hunaniaeth ac yn gallu cyfranogi'n llawn ym mywyd yr ysgol.

Bydd cyflawniad disgyblion yn cael ei fonitro a byddwn yn defnyddio'r data hwn i gefnogi disgyblion, codi safonau a sicrhau addysgu cynhwysol. Byddwn yn mynd i'r afael â gwahaniaethu trwy fynd ati mewn ffordd gadarnhaol i hybu cydraddoldeb, herio bwllo a stereoteipiau a chreu amgylchedd sy'n hyrwyddo parch tuag at bawb. Yn Ysgol Cynwyd Sant, rydym ni'n credu bod amrywiaeth yn gryfder a ddylai gael ei barchu a'i ddathlu gan bawb sy'n dysgu, yn addysgu ac yn dod ar ymweliad yma.

*At Ysgol Cynwyd Sant we are committed to ensuring equality of education and opportunity for all pupils, staff, parents and carers receiving services from the school, irrespective of disability, race, gender, age, sexual orientation, religion or belief, gender reassignment, pregnancy and maternity, marriage and civil partnership. We aim to develop a culture of inclusion and diversity in which all those connected to the school feel proud of their identity and able to participate fully in school life.*

*The achievement of pupils will be monitored and we will use this data to support pupils, raise standards and ensure inclusive teaching. ## Rheolau'r Ysgol / Disgyblaeth School Rules / Discipline

Mae'r ysgol yn gweithredu polisi disgyblaeth gadarn. Cred yr ysgol fod gan blant hawl i drefn a disgyblaeth a fydd yn eu galluogi i weithio'n dawel a diogel. Disgwylir i'r plant ymddwyn yn gydnaws â safonau a gwerthoedd a feithrinir gan yr ysgol. Cred yr ysgol fod rhieni yn chwarae rhan holl bwysig yn ymddygiad eu plant.

Mae gan yr ysgol bump rheol:

- 1) Ymdrechaf i siarad Cymraeg.
- 2) Ymdrechaf i fod yn onest a dweud y gwir.
- 3) Ymdrechaf i drïo fy ngorau glas a dyfalbarhau.
- 4) Ymdrechaf i barchu fy hun ac eraill.
- 5) Ymdrechaf i fod yn garedig a meddwl am deimladau eraill.

Y Pennaeth gyda chymorth y Dirprwy a staff dysgu'r ysgol sy'n gyfrifol am ddisgyblaeth yr ysgol ac am sicrhau ymateb i reolau'r ysgol. Mae'r pwyslais ar ddatblygu hunanddisgyblaeth, fel bo trefn a gofal yn rhan annatod o ethos yr ysgol.

Pan fydd angen disgyblu plentyn fe wneir trwy siarad gyda'r plentyn a cholli cyfle. Os na fydd y plentyn yn ymateb i'r camau hyn bydd y Pennaeth yn cysylltu'r â'r rhieni er mwyn trafod y mater gyda nhw.

*The school operates a firm discipline policy. The school believes that all children have the right to discipline and order which enables them to work in a quiet and safe environment. The school expects children to behave in a manner which reflects the standards and values of the school. The school believes that parents play a crucial part in the behaviour of their children.*

*The school has five main rules:*

- 1) *I will endeavour to speak Welsh.*
- 2) *I will endeavour to be honest and always tell the truth.*
- 3) *I will endeavour to try my best and persevere.*
- 4) *I will endeavour to respect myself and others.*
- 5) *I will endeavour to be kind and think of other people's feelings.*

*The Headteacher aided by the Deputy and teaching staff of the school are responsible for the discipline of the school and that the children adhere to the school rules. The importance of self-discipline is emphasised to ensure order and care which is an essential part of the school's ethos.*

*When it is essential to discipline a child, it is done through talking to him/her and loss of privilege. If the child fails to respond to these steps then the Headteacher will contact the child's parents to discuss the matter with them.*

## Anabledd / Disability

Mae'r ysgol wedi ymrwymo i sicrhau mynediad llawn i'r adeilad ac i'r cwricwlwm i'w disgyblion, beth bynnag yw eu cred, hil, gallu, rhyw neu anghenion addysgol ychwanegol. Yr is-bwyllgor Iechyd & Diogelwch y Llywodraethwyr sydd â chyfrifoldeb o oruchwylio hwn.

*The school is duty bound to ensure that there is access to the building and to the curriculum whatever the beliefs, ability, race, additional education needs of the pupils. The Health & Safety sub-committee is responsible for overseeing this.*

## Plant Mewn Gofal Child Looked After (CLA)

Yr aelodau o staff sydd â chyfrifoldeb dros blant mewn gofal gan sicrhau cefnogaeth a hybu eu cyrhaeddiad addysgiadol yw Mrs S.G.D. Richards (Pennaeth) a Mrs S Jenkins (Goruwchwylydd Cyflenwi).

*The members of staff with responsibility for looked after children and for supporting and promoting their educational achievement is Mrs S.G.D. Richards (Headteacher) and Mrs S. Jenkins (Cover Supervisor).*





## Chwaraeon / Sports

Anelir at ddarparu cymaint o brofiadau ag y gellir ym myd chwaraeon i'r plant. Defnyddir cyfleusterau cymunedol gan gynnwys y pwll nofio a chae Parc Tudur ynghyd â rhedfeydd yr ysgol ac ardaloedd gwyrdd.

*We aim to provide as many sporting opportunities as possible for the pupils. In addition to using the school yards and grassed areas, we also use the community amenities such as the swimming pool and pitch at Tudor Park.*

## Gweithgareddau Allgyrsiol Extra-curricular Activities

Fel ysgol Gymraeg, anogir y plant i gymryd rhan yng ngweithgareddau'r Urdd. Cynhelir rhai o'r gweithgareddau tu allan i oriau ysgol. Rydym hefyd yn cynnal amrywiaeth o glybiau e.e. Pêl-rwyd, Rygbi, Pêl-droed, cyfrifiaduron, pobi, garddio, Celf ac leithoedd modern. Mae plant hŷn yr ysgol yn derbyn y cyfle i fynd am ymweliad preswyl i Langrannog.

*As a Welsh medium school, we encourage the children to participate in the Urdd activities. Some of the activities are held outside of school hours. We conduct a variety of clubs such as; Netball, Football, Rugby, baking, Computer, gardening, art and Modern languages which alternate on a termly basis. The older children also have the opportunity of a residential visit at Llangrannog.*



## Cysylltiadau / Links

Mae cysylltiadau da rhwng rhieni'r ysgol a'r ysgol ei hun. Mae gan yr ysgol Gymdeithas Rieni ac Athrawon (CRhA) '**Cyfeillion Cynwyd Sant**' sy'n weithgar iawn wrth gefnogi'r ysgol yn arian-nol. Gwahoddir rhieni i'r ysgol tair gwaith y flwyddyn i drafod cynnydd addysgol eu plant. Ar ddiwedd y flwyddyn academiaidd rhoddir adroddiad ysgrifenedig llawn i'r rhieni a chyfle i ddathlu llwyddiannau'r flwyddyn trwy ymweld â'r Ysgol i edrych ar waith y flwyddyn.

*There are good links between the parents and the school itself. The school has a Parent Teacher Association (PTA) '**Cyfeillion Cynwyd Sant**' which is hard working in giving financial support to the school. Parents are invited to the school three times a year to discuss their child's progress with the class teacher. At the end of the academic year the parents receive a full written report and an opportunity to celebrate the year's successes by visiting the School to look at the year's work.*

## Dysgu Adref / Home Learning

Caiff Dysgu Adref ei roi yn ôl doethineb yr athro/awes ac fel estyniad o waith ysgol y plentyn gyda ffocws cryf ar ddatblygu sgiliau darllen y disgyblion. Gofynnwn am eich cymorth i sicrhau bod y gwaith yn cael ei gwblhau a'i dychwelyd yn brydlon, yn gynnwys y cofnodion darllen yn wythnosol.

*Home Learning is given at the discretion of the class teacher and is an extension of the child's classroom work with a strong focus on developing the pupils reading skills. We ask for your co-operation is assisting your child to complete tasks and to ensure that the work is returned to school on time including re-turning the reading record weekly.*

## Byw'n Iach / Healthy Living

Mae Ysgol Cynwyd Sant wedi derbyn statws 'Ysgol Iach'. Mae'r ysgol yn annog bwyta ac yfed yn iach ac yn cynnal siop ffrwythau dyddiol. Rydym yn annog disgyblion i yfed digon o ddŵr yn ystod y dydd. Annogir disgyblion sy'n dod â phhecyn bwyd i drafod opsiynau iach gyda'u rhieni.

*Ysgol Cynwyd Sant has received the 'Healthy School' status. The school encourages eating and drinking healthily and operates a fruit shop daily. We encourage pupils to keep themselves hydrated at all times (water). Pupils who bring lunch boxes are encouraged to discuss healthy options with their parents.*



## Ethos yr Ysgol / School Ethos

### Care, support and guidance: Good

The school develops pupils' social and cultural skills very successfully. A very strong emphasis is placed on developing pupils' self-confidence by encouraging them to take responsibility for their own learning, work with others and use their thinking skills effectively to solve problems. The school has comprehensive procedures for ensuring care, support and guidance for pupils. This has a positive effect on their standards and wellbeing; for example, pupils receive valuable lessons on how to stay safe on the internet as a natural part of their ICT lessons. The school's provision for developing pupils' spiritual and cultural attitudes is very effective, for example through collective worship sessions. By welcoming visitors from foreign countries to the school, staff reinforce pupils' understanding of different cultures and beliefs successfully. (Estyn 2016)

### Gofal, cymorth ac arweiniad: Da

Mae'r ysgol yn datblygu medrau cymdeithasol a diwylliannol disgyblion yn llwyddiannus iawn. Rhoddir pwyslais cryf iawn ar ddatblygu hunanhyder disgyblion trwy eu hannog i gymryd cyfrifoldeb am eu dysgu eu hunain, gweithio gydag eraill a thrwy ddefnyddio'u medrau meddwl yn effeithiol i ddatrys problemau. Mae gan yr ysgol weithdrefnau cynhwysfawr ar gyfer sicrhau gofal, cymorth ac arweiniad i ddisgyblion. Mae hyn yn cael effaith gadarnhaol ar eu safonau a'u lles. Er enghraifft, mae disgyblion yn derbyn gwersi gwerthfawr ar sut i gadw'n ddiogel ar y rhyngwrdd fel rhan naturiol o'u gwersi TGCh. ## Addysg Cydberthnas a Rhywioldeb Relationship & Sexuality Education

Dysgir Addysg Ryw fel pwnc ar wahân i blant blwyddyn 6 yn unig drwy wahodd nyrs yr ysgol i ymdrîn â'r pwnc mewn modd sensitif a phroffesiynol. Gwahoddir Rieni/ Gwarcheidwaid i'r Ysgol cyn y gwersi er mwyn cael gweld yr adnoddau. *Sex Education is taught as a separate subject to Year 6 through inviting the school nurse to the school to talk to the children in a sensitive and professional way. Parents/ Guardians are invited to view the resources prior to the lessons. In addition to this, teachers address this subject with all pupils when aspects occur within other curriculum areas.*

### *If you are unhappy for any reason....*

*There is an Official Complaints Procedure available to answer any complaints you might have. You are welcome to make an appointment with the Headteacher to discuss any concern you might have.*

*There are three stages to the Complaints Procedure;*

**Stage 1:** *Raise your complaint (usually with the class teacher initially), normally within 10 school days. If you are a pupil, you may choose to raise your concern with the class teacher or other appropriate member of staff.*

**Stage 2:** *Write to the headteacher\*, normally within 5 school days. The headteacher will investigate your complaint and may arrange to meet you. You will receive a written response to your complaint, normally within 10 school days of the investigation being completed.*

**Stage 3:** *Write to the Chair of governors\*\*, normally within 5 school days. The complaints committee of the governing body will consider the complaint. This will include a meeting with all the parties, which will normally be within 15 school days. You will be informed of the outcome in writing, normally within 10 school days of the meeting.*

**NOTES:** *It is in everyone's best interest for concerns and complaints to be resolved as soon as possible but all timescales shown are flexible. The school will agree different timescales with you, when necessary, to ensure that adequate time is allowed for a thorough examination of the issues and with the aim of achieving an answer to the problem.*

*\* If the complaint is about the headteacher, you should write to the chair of governors via the school's address.*

*\*\* If the complaint is about the chair of governors, you should write to the vice chair of governors, via the school's address.*
